Our facility will also be available for public use and for all other youth sports programs and sports leagues in Mesa County. The benefits of the Blackout Sports Fieldhouse are far reaching in youth sports, adult sports and economic growth opportunities for businesses in Mesa County.

Our \$7 million capital campaign is designated for the construction of our Blackout Sports Fieldhouse. Through the generous support of local businesses and grants we have raised / pledged \$6 million of our goal, with \$1 million left to raise.

BLACKOUT SPORTS FIELDHOUSE CHALLENGES, OPPORTUNITIES AND SOLUTIONS

A. MESA COUNTY YOUTH AND SPORTS ORGANIZATIONS

Increased Opportunity for Mesa County Youth

The Blackout Sports Fieldhouse will provide the required space and resources needed to allow all local youth sports organizations and clubs to execute their operational activities - including practice, gym resources, tournament hosting, and a facility where they can host home games. Having this facility resource will raise our local youth athlete's skill levels, making them more competitive on state and national levels. In turn, this will increase their exposure to prospective college programs when they endeavor to continue competing at higher levels.

Our fieldhouse will provide the youth in our community with resources, which are not yet available, to stay active and healthy. Our facility will provide organizational support, which will help them in their competitive endeavors by increasing opportunities to participate in sports leagues and tournaments. This will allow our youth to prepare more and bring a more competitive edge when their teams compete with larger organizations such as those in Salt Lake City and Denver.

CURRENT CHALLENGES

Lack of dependable space needed for regular practice schedules, hosting tournaments and hosting games

- Community resources available for increasing skill levels of local youth athletes have reached a plateau due to lack of dependable training facilities, lack of gymnasium space, lack of facilities required for execution for successful sports training programs
- Lack of after school spaces/activities for youth to combat alarming mental health issues in Western Colorado; "solutions" create more positive after school experiences for atrisk youth.

OPPORTUNITIES

- Create a source of dependability and security for youth training facilities, gymnasium space and training programs
- Provide a catalyst for improved efficacy of training and training resources
- Create a hub for local sports leagues and organizations
- Increase opportunities for youth to be more competitive in sports in state and national levels
- Increase exposure of local youth to prospective college programs when they endeavor to continue competing at higher levels

B. GJ BLACKOUT YOUTH BASKETBALL CLUB

Simple Solution for Youth Involved with GJ Blackout Youth Basketball Club

Our fieldhouse will be a permanent solution to our organization's most significant ongoing challenge – securing gym time. While Mesa County Valley School District 51 has been generous with us over the years, it is difficult to obtain the availability of gym time due to the mass number of school-sanctioned activities. When our youth basketball club has its future fieldhouse, gym time will be guaranteed and secured permanently.

The fieldhouse will allow us room for expansion of our programs which will accommodate the increased interest of youth participation in our club. We are currently limited on accepting new participants primarily due to the lack of available gym time.

The GJ Blackout facility will allow us to host tournaments throughout the year for our own youth basketball club and for many clubs in Mesa County and our neighboring communities. This will increase our availability and attraction to participation in our tournaments from our larger city neighbors.

CURRENT CHALLENGES

- Lack of secure gymnasium time and space
- Lack of opportunity for expansion of our programs
- Unable to accommodate increased interest of youth participation in our club
- Unable to host tournaments to meet our club's needs

These visitors will include families, participants, coaches, friends, and even referees and their guests, who will attend our hosted games and tournaments. Of course, they will need food, lodging and fuel – but they will inevitably patron local shopping opportunities and maximize their own exposure to the beauty and adventure our community has to offer.

CURRENT CHALLENGES

Mesa County does not currently attract this specific demographic

- Mesa County economic opportunities are lacking for local businesses due to inflation and other residual effects from COVID
- Local club and league sports organizations are in need of financial and logistical growth

- Hosting regional games and tournaments for a variety of types of athletics programs
- Facility grounds is located near I-70 providing quick access to each town in Mesa County, near the shopping district in west Grand Junction and provides a convenient proximity to lodging
- Increased attraction from neighboring youth sports organizations
- Increased attraction from people who are directly involved with youth sports organizations in neighboring communities
